We're delighted that our garden tour can help the hungry as we partner with the Rice Raiser Campaign global projects and the work of Hunger Response International.



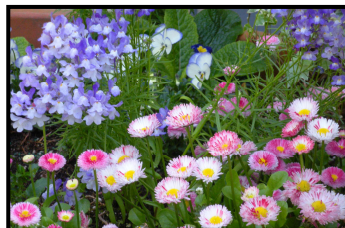

**1. Don and Merla Goertz, 1890 Skyline Drive
"Tophouse Delight"**

This well established hillside garden in a stately neighbourhood demonstrates the beauty that can be created by implementing a cohesive vision over time.

Parking along the road.

**2. Salvation Army Hope Centre, 34081 Gladys Ave
"Healing Garden" Judy Loewen and David Darbey**

Participants in the Salvation Army recovery programs are given opportunity to contribute and heal while working on this living roof garden, atop their Hope Centre.

Parking in parking lot. Enjoy a free barbecue and live music after 4:00 pm.

**3. James and Sylvia Barlow, 1652 King Crescent
"Whispering Waters"**

Intimate seating areas, beautiful wooden structures with climbing plants, a pond, waterfall, and a natural green belt make this garden cozy, restful and nourishing for the soul.

Parking along the road. The no-parking signs apply to arena event days.

**4. Alan and Susan Suderman, 1566 Tracey Street
"Shady Acres Poultry"**

On an active farm, this lovely country yard is meticulously clean and tidy. Pause pool-side and enjoy the beautifully peaceful setting.

Parking in the driveway.

**5. Gord and Karen Bergen, 30277 Sunset Crescent
"The Gathering Garden"**

Inspired by the natural beauty of the West Coast, the Bergens have turned their $\frac{3}{4}$ acre into a delightful meeting place for friends and family. Orphaned and shared plants have played an integral role in the creation of this garden.

Park on driveway or road. Washroom available in the shop.

**6. Rob and Janis Westlund, 29903 Glengarry Ave
"Bridle Hill Garden"**

This country horse farm is lined with beautiful old trees and shrubs which have been uniquely pruned into topiary shapes.

Parking along the road. Please walk up the driveway. Handicapped parking available near the house.

7. Mount Lehman Greenhouses, 6592 Mt. Lehman Rd

The vegetable gardeners among you will appreciate this educational tour of a local, working greenhouse. Learn how peppers, tomatoes and cucumbers are grown without spraying or pesticides.

Parking in the parking lot.
