## WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

### CHECK IN



Check in begins 15mins before the service starts. Your child will be assigned a number and you will receive a

pager with that same number. At this time please inform the nursery supervisor of any special instructions. Our nursery can be busy before and between services. You may want to come early to guarantee a spot for your child.

**\*If your child begins to cry and cannot be comforted— or if your child needs a diaper change, your pager will light up and vibrate. At that time come immediately to the Nursery.**

### CHECK OUT

When picking up your child, ring bell to notify the supervisor and be sure to present your nursery pager that will match the number of your baby's tag. No child will be released without that pager—even if we have known you for years. Then collect your diaper bag or any items left for your child and have a great day.



### SAFETY & SECURITY

We work hard to keep our babies and toddlers safe and secure. Here are the rules to adhere by:

- Volunteers in our nursery are to be parents or grandparents and cleared volunteers. Anyone else will be asked to leave immediately.
- All volunteers have to complete a Police Check. They will also need to fill out an application form and complete an interview and training.
- Parents who consistently stay will also be asked to fill out a Police Check and participate in volunteer training.
- Volunteers must be at least 14 years of age.
- The volunteer/child ratio must be adhered to - 1 adult to 3 children, 1 teen to 2 children.
- Volunteers are not allowed to change diapers—parents will be notified.
- No one is allowed past the sign-in counter unless cleared by the supervisor. Please ring the bell if you need to talk to the supervisor.
- Workers are taught safety procedures in case of emergencies.



### A HEALTHY PLACE

To keep our nursery a healthy place the toys, equipment, and linens are sanitized every week. Also, please make sure that your baby is well when you come to the nursery. **\*\*If the supervisor notices that your child has a runny nose, cough, rash or fever, you will be called to pick up your child.**

### ROOM TO GROW

Our nursery has three supervised rooms for our babies:

- **Sleeping Room** - a quiet room with cribs and clean linens.
- **Crawlers** - a room for children who are not yet walking with age appropriate toys and equipment.
- **Walkers** - for toddlers walking confidently with age appropriate toys and activities.



### SNACKS

Arrowroot cookies and Baby Mum-Mums are available as snacks in the nursery. If your child has a special diet or allergy, please inform the Supervisor.
