- **Monday:** An easy hike in the Mission area with an afternoon at a local lake.
- **Tuesday:** Community Service in the morning with an afternoon spent at Giggle Ridge at Cultus Lake.
- **Wednesday:** A day at Cultus Lake Waterslides.
- **Thursday:** This day begins in the afternoon when we meet at 4pm & head out for a sleepover at Northview Mission campus. It's going to be a great time complete with BBQ, Smores, activities, campfire time & more. Pick up **Friday** 11 am.
