### **Big Question:**

When the world looks at the church, do they see a love that can only be explained by the supernatural work of God? That is a big QUESTION for our life together. There must be such a love if this text is to make any sense.

#### 5 Reasons why God's LOVE is so important & what it means for us:

1 John 4:16 We know how much God loves us, and we have put our trust in his love. God is love, and all who live in love \_\_\_\_\_ in God, and God in them.



God is so absolute, so perfect, so complete, so full, so inexhaustibly resourceful, so joyful, that he is by nature a Giver, a Worker for others, a Helper, a Protector. What it means to be God is to be full enough always to overflow. The implications of this for the way we live are big.

## 2 Loving Each Other Is Like Loving God

One time a lawyer asked Jesus (*Matthew 22:36*), " <sup>36</sup> "Teacher, which is the most important commandment in the law of Moses?"

In other words, tell us what is the most important \_\_\_\_\_ of all of the Old Testament commandments? Jesus answered,

**Matthew 22:37-38** <sup>37</sup> **Jesus replied,** "'You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind.' <sup>38</sup> This is the first and greatest commandment."

But then the lawyer got more than he bargained for. Jesus didn't stop. He said

Matthew 22:39 A second is equally important: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.

Jesus said loving each other is like loving God. The two commandments are inseparable.
