Ephesians 6:10-17 LOOK

- 1. Read 1 Eph. 6:10-17
- What stands out to you from the passage?
- What seems important to you?
- Find the who, what, where, when, how of the passage.
- What ideas or words are repeated?

LEARN

- 1. Read Isa. 59:14-20
- What is the problem Isaiah sees in Israel when he writes these words?
- Who is the person who is going to "put on" this armor?

2. Read Luke 4:1-13

- How do we see Satan waiting for the opportune time to go and attack Jesus?
- How do we see Jesus using the armor of God to stand firm and resist Satan's attacks?

LIVE

- We see that the armor is necessary and effective in the fight against Satan and his schemes.
- Which piece of armor do you find the easiest to put on? Which is hardest?
- Output on the armor?
 - Where is a place in your life you can put on the belt of truth and speak biblical truth to a person or situation?
 - Where is a place in your life where you can put on the shoes of peace and make peace in a difficult situation or relationship?
 - Where is a place in your life that you can put on the shield of faith and persevere in the face of suffering and difficulty?
- 2. Where is a place that you need to "take a stand" in the spiritual war you are fighting?
- Spend some time in smaller groups (2-3 persons) and pray for strength to face the attacks of Satan as he seeks to entice you to sin.
- Brainstorm a small step you can take in putting on the armor to take your stand against Satan's schemes.
