- What stands out to you from the passage?
- O What seems important to you?

## 1. Read Psalm 109:1-5

- What causes David to cry out to God in this passage?
- What is David's response to the suffering he faces?

#### 2. Read Jude 19-21

- What is the primary difference between "worldly" people and Jude's audience (called "you" or "beloved" in v.20)?
- How does Jude teach his audience to pray?
- Why should they pray?

## LIVE

This text is filled with exhortations to pray: pray always, for all the saints, make all kinds of prayers, etc.

- The first situation Paul has in mind is the Christian's spiritual warfare against Satan's schemes (v.11).
  - Take some time to pray for Christians in your life (CG, workplace, friends, family, etc.). Pray that they will "keep alert with all perseverance" as they face Satan's schemes.
  - Take some time and pray for the struggle against sin in your own life. Ask for God's Spirit to give you the strength to stand in the evil day (v.13)! This can be a time of silent confession, or you can break into groups of 2-3 if you feel comfortable doing that.
- The second situation Paul has in mind, is the proclamation of the gospel (v.19).
  - Take some time to pray for the teaching ministry of Northview's staff as they proclaim the gospel.
  - Take some time to pray for boldness in your own life as you have opportunities to share the gospel with friends and co-workers.
