MINISTRY CONTEXT:

- e. Recruit, train and equip volunteer teams to engage various community outreach ministry initiatives.

2. Other Duties (10%)

- a. Staff meetings, Global Missions Team Meetings.
- b. Other duties as assigned by Lead Pastor and/or Executive Pastor of Ministry Development.

STATEMENT OF RELATIONSHIPS

The Local Outreach Coordinator will report directly to the Local and Global Missions Pastor. The Local and Global Missions Pastor reports to the Executive Pastor of Ministry Development.
