UNDERSTAND THEIR STORY

1. What do you learn about the people mentioned in this text: their experiences, emotions, attitudes, need for a Savior?
2. What do you learn about God in this text: His character, nature, His ability & willingness to save?

3. How did the weekend sermon help you to understand the situation of the original audience (the Israelites)? What do you remember from the message about the situation they were in?
For additional Old Testament History, review questions from Day 2 of the Devotional
