Apply to Our Story

1. Start by sharing one thing that stood out or you had questions about from the lesson.

2. We still suffer with physical "uncleanness" as a reality of living in a broken world. We are no longer told to send those who do "outside the camp", so, based on how Jesus treated those who physically suffered, what should our response be?
 - a. How do we respond to our own physical discomfort or pain? How ought we to respond in light of the work of Jesus? (Read 2 Cor. 1:3-7 for some comfort and 2 Cor. 4:17 for some perspective)

3. We discussed how God cares about how we treat others. Can you think of a time when you noticed how a broken relationship with another person impacted your relationship with God?
 - a. How might understanding that "breaking faith" with others is also "breaking faith" with the LORD influence how you treat those around you (friends, family members, spouses, coworkers etc.)?

4. What do you think God's disposition is towards you most of the time? Is he far off or close? Pleased with you or disappointed?
 - a. Do you feel like he wants to dwell with and bless you, that he looks at you with favor? If not, how would it impact you if you did?

5. Consider sharing from your ADORATION, CONFESSION and SUPPLICATION in light of God's word (pg. 27). As you close in prayer, take some time to pray the Num. 6 blessing for one another one more time.
