	Teaching Moment: Etiological Tale / Themed Story (Numbers 11:1-3)

Apply to our Story

1) Have you faced a "wilderness" experience which has tested your faith? If you are comfortable briefly share about the experience and what you learned (or are learning) from it?
2	The Isrealites complained about God's provision, and God's promises. We too can lose sight of what he IS providing for us now, and of the value of his future promises. What has God reminded you to be grateful for, in the middle of wilderness situations?
3) How comfortable are you with complaining to God? Do you do this? Why or Why not. If you do, how & when do you complain to God (verbally, in written format, other ways)?
4	Pray together using the Adoration / Confession / Supplication prompts. How does Numbers 11 teach you to adore God? What does it teach you to confess? What can you ask God for?
