

God is Faithful

Numbers 26 and 27

1. God is faithful, despite Israel's past (Num 26:1-65)

2. God is faithful in the present (Num 27:1-11)

3. God is faithful with the future of God's people (Num 27:12-23)

1. Despite the past failed generation and leadership, God has brought about a new generation of equal magnitude to continue His promises to Israel. 3. Specifically look at the meaning of the name Joshua (The LORD is my salvation, The LORD saves or The LORD is Salvation).
How many ways does Jesus Save? Or, what are all the things Jesus' Salvation accomplishes?
How does this encourage and embolden you today?
