- 1. Read 1 Thes. 4:11-12
 - a. What is the ideal Christian life according to this passage?
 - b. How does 1 Tim. 2:1-2 answer this question?

- 2. Read 1 Tim. 4:6-10
 - a. What does this passage add to the Christian life?
 - b. In the Christian life, what sort of things ought to be avoided?
 - c. In the Christian life, what sort of things ought to be pursued?

APPLY TO OUR STORY

The lesson in Php. 2:19-30 is that our lives matter more, and less than we tend to think.

1. We learned to not overestimate ourselves and embrace the obscurity of living godly lives.

- a. What is one character strength that others have affirmed in you?
- b. What is one character weakness, where you recognize room to grow?
- 2. We learned not to underestimate ourselves, and embrace our influence:
 - a. Who is one person that you have proximity with (you see in person more than once a week)?
 - i. What is one thing you can do/say to make a positive impact on them?
 - b. What is something you can do as a group to impact those around you?

Supplication: What can you ask God for, as a result of studying this text?
