There ought not to be people who break the law!	There are convicts in Britain	World's solution: Britain can be free of convicts, .... if we send all lawbreakers to Australia!	World's view of future: British society will be pure because we've gotten rid of the lawbreakers.
		Christian solution: Britain can be free of convicts if the Holy Spirit changes hearts and people become followers of Jesus. <b>SO</b> - we share the Gospel AND support laws & legal reform.	Christian view of future: Until Jesus returns, lawbreakers will be present in every country because of sin in the human heart. BUT there will be no lawbreakers in the news heavens and new earth.

All people ought to be viewed as equals. Racism should not exist.	Racist	World's solution: Racism can be abolished if we educate people, and remove all economic, political and social structures of inequality.	World's view of the future: We will be able to defeat racism and happily co-exist as we evolve as a human species.
		Christian solution: Racism is reduced when people learn to see all people as equal, created in the image of God. <b>So</b> - we share the Gospel AND seek to promote racial equality.	Christian view of the future: We will always have to fight racism because of sin in the human heart, but it will be eradicated in the new heavens and new earth.

What combination of realism and hope motivates you as a Christian?</p>

Give options to support organizations.	<b>#3 Motivation &amp; Hope</b> We are global citizens, even if we don't recognize it. In the new heavens and new earth, all nationalities will worship God.
