"Loving The Lost" – A Community Group Prayer Guide

Community Groups are a helpful support for participating in the mission of God.

This prayer guide is designed to help you pray together for those far from Jesus, by name.

We each know someone who is distant from God.

Either they've drifted from Jesus, or haven't yet decided to follow him.

We pray with the conviction that Jesus "came to seek and to save the lost." (See Luke 19:10.)

Make a list of people to pray for by name.¹

- When first adding someone to your group's list: share about your relationship with each person.
- When returning to pray for your group's list: give the group updates about where they are in life / faith.

• Pray for them with Scripture as a starting point.

Jump right into prayer, or get people to look these texts up and read them aloud before you head into a time of prayer.

"Lord, I pray that you draw to yourself." (John 6:44)
"I pray that you would nudge to seek you." (Acts 17:27)
"I pray that hears and believes the Word of God." (1 Thessalonians 2:13)
"I pray that you would empower to grasp your love." (Ephesians 3:17-18)
"Prevent Satan from blinding to the truth." (2 Corinthians 4:4, 2 Timothy 2:25-26)
"Holy Spirit, convict of their need for Jesus." (John 16:8, 1 Thessalonians 1:5)
"Lord, send someone that will faithfully share the gospel with" (Matthew 9:37-38)

"God of hope, thank you that I can trust you. Fill me with your joy and peace and hope." (Romans 15:13)

"Thank you for being the one who is able to do far more than I've asked or imagined." (Ephesians 3:20-21)
